Travel information

There are no organised transfers from Frankfurt Airport to Wiesbaden.

Arriving by taxi from Frankfurt Airport

Taxis are available around the clock at both terminals and the long-distance train station. Large-capacity taxis for up to seven persons are also available in the Frankfurt area. Taxi companies near to the airport are for example:

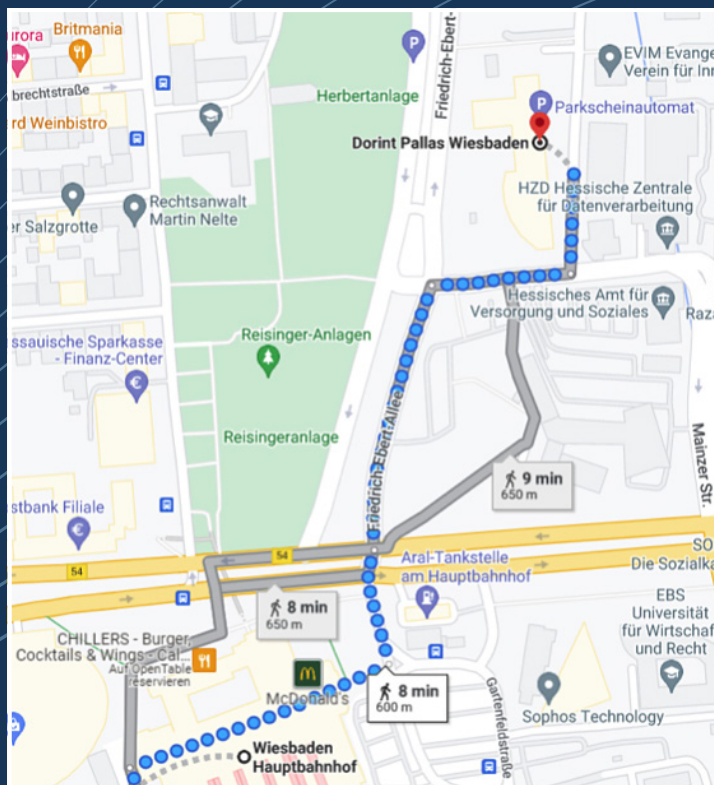

The trip from the airport to Wiesbaden city center (and vice versa) takes approximately 30 to 40 minutes, depending on traffic.

When driving back to Frankfurt Airport after the Industry Days, it is advised to inform the taxi driver of the name of your airline. You will then be taken to the right terminal and dropped off at the curb as close as possible to your check-in counter. ▶

Arriving by train from Frankfurt Airport

From Frankfurt Airport to Wiesbaden, it is best to take the S8 or S9 connections, which alternate every 15 minutes from station "Frankfurt Flughafen Regionalbahnhof" and stops at Wiesbaden Central Station. The travel time is about 45 minutes. Train tickets can be purchased directly at the counter at the train station "Frankfurt Flughafen Regionalbahnhof". From Wiesbaden Central Station it is just a few minutes to the Dorint Hotel and the RheinMain CongressCenter by foot. All other hotels are quiet close to Dorint Hotel and RheinMain CongressCenter. If you need a taxi in Wiesbaden you can just call +49 611 99 999 (central taxi number for the city of Wiesbaden). Besides that, Uber is also available in Wiesbaden.

(Walking) distances in Wiesbaden

The venues in Wiesbaden are close together. From the RheinMain CongressCenter you can reach by foot:

- ... Hotel Dorint Pallas in 5 minutes
- ... Hotel Mercure in 5 minutes
- ... Hotel Nassauer Hof in 11 minutes
- ... Kurhaus (first evening event) in 13 minutes
- ... Hotel Adina in 14 minutes

If guests staying at Hotel Nassauer Hof or Hotel Adina want to take the bus to the RMCC, bus lines 1 and 8 are the best options. The right bus station will be "Kochbrunnen" (for Adina Hotel) and bus station "Kurhaus/Theater" (for Hotel Nassauer Hof). The bus ride takes about 8 minutes. You can get the ticket at the counter at the bus station or directly from the driver.

Dress Code

There is **no general obligation to wear masks indoors**. But there are a few exceptions, for example for:

Exploring Wiesbaden: Sight seeing & tourist attractions

Do you have some free time before you return home? Don't miss out on some of Wiesbaden's most beautiful sights! The following selection of attractions can easily be explored by foot!

Kurhaus & Casino

Wiesbaden's landmark. Neoclassicism building from 1907 and opened by Kaiser Wilhelm II. The Casino is one of the oldest casinos in the world.

Hessian State Theatre

The Hessian State Theatre, which was built in 1894 on behalf of Kaiser Wilhelm II, is one of the most successful German language theatres.

"Kurpark" and Park "Warmer Damm"

Popular urban parks in Wiesbaden around Kurhaus & Casino with extensive ponds and water fountains.

Square "Kranzplatz" and fountain "Kochbrunnen"

In 1945 bombs destroyed a part of the historic Kranzplatz, but the Kochbrunnentempel and a rest of the colonnade give a glimpse of the former splendour. The Kochbrunnen on Kranzplatz is not only a landmark, but also an often frequented place for health-conscious people.

Square “Luisenplatz” and Church St. Boniface

The Luisenplatz is an example of impressive room design in Classicism. On the Luisenplatz is the Roman Catholic Church of St. Boniface, the oldest church in downtown Wiesbaden.

Market square and Church “Marktkirche”

Next to Church St. Boniface you find the market square and the Church Marktkirche. Numerous seasonal traders offer a wide variety of products during the weekly market.

Park “Herbert- und Reisinger-Anlagen”

In 1932, on the initiative of the founders Hugo Reisinger and Adam Herbert, the former railway property, located directly in front of the main station, was converted into a green area.
