- ❖ Development of resources and incentives to overcome all barriers some lotteries lack resources for basic actions like training or measuring emissions.
- There's no one-size-fits-all resources provided will be tailored as much as possible and will evolve over time
- In order to benefit from the Support Programme, Lotteries must commit online



The Support Programme for Lotteries Goals

The objective is to help ALL EL lotteries improve their environmental IMPACT now – because we can't afford to wait or delay actions



especially those with <u>limited resources</u> – what is simple for one lottery may not be for another



irrespective of your size or operating mode- *lotteries have* different scopes and operations



not just those in the EU – regulations can't be the only driver to cover all lotteries




