- Established in 2012
- Aims to prevent match-fixing and building awareness among stakeholders
- Financed (partly) through funding from the Austrian Federal Ministry for Sports
- Stakeholder approach incl. sports- and betting industry as well as public authorities and public administration
- Prevention work in face-to-face workshops with athletes, staff, functionaries, officials and other stakeholders
- Knowledge transfer and expert contributions in/to international Projects






